Creative Wellness Practitioner Appointed to the Michigan Board of Acupuncture

EAST LANSING—Creative Wellness, the largest massage therapy center in Michigan, is pleased to announce that one of its acupuncturists, Annie Haas, has been appointed by Governor Jennifer Granholm to the Michigan Board of Acupuncture.

The Michigan Public Health Code was amended in July 2006 to provide the registration of acupuncturists. The Board is made up of seven acupuncturists, three Michigan licensed physicians, and three public members. Haas will represent acupuncturists for a term commencing August 25, 2010 and expiring June 30, 2014.

The World Health Organization recognizes acupuncture as a non-invasive and effective method of treating over 43 common disorders including arthritis, migraine headaches, insomnia, low back, neck and shoulder pain, food allergies, infertility in both men and women, premenstrual syndrome, sexual dysfunction, and alcohol, nicotine and drug addiction.
